Duties:

- Implement performance and leadership education at off-season camps and during the summer tour
- Collaborate with the percussion educational team to ensure pedagogical approach and staff culture align with the expectations of the Madison Scouts program
- Teach one-to-one lessons during the offseason to tenor performers via MadU, Virtual Learning
- Additional duties as assigned by the Acting Battery Caption Head

Qualifications:

- Minimum 21 years of age
- Pass a criminal background check and reference check
- Full COVID-19 vaccination
- Availability to teach one-to-one virtual lessons throughout the offseason - flexible scheduling
- Availability to attend winter camps on Nov. 19-21, Dec. 28-Jan. 1, and Apr. 29-May 1, 2022
- Substantial availability between June 3, 2022 to August 13, 2022
- Candidates with experience teaching world class DCI or WGI organizations are preferred
