



## Food Operations Manager

**Description:** The Madison Scouts Drum and Bugle Corps is seeking one Food Operations Manager to assist with the following duties during their 2022 summer season from June 3-August 13.

### **Duties:**

- Ensure effective and timely execution corps-designed nutrition & meal plan.
- Develop the food operations budget with the assistance of the Business Manager.
- Manage food purchasing and budget tracking procedures with the assistance of the Business Manager.
- Coordinate and ensure a world-class experience for a team of volunteers with varied levels of food preparation experience.
- Ensure compliance to all truck safety and food handling procedures.
- Assist with other duties as assigned by the Business Manager.

### **Qualifications:**

- All candidates must be at least 21 years of age, have a valid driver's license, pass a criminal background check, have received full COVID-19 vaccination, and be available from June 3, 2022 to August 13, 2022. It is critical that candidates have access to a reliable laptop and cell phone with data plan.
- Experience touring as a Food Operations Manager or volunteer with a Drum and Bugle Corps is preferred.



**Additional Information:**

The Food Operations Manager will be in a live-in position with the drum corps. Once competition begins the contractor will travel with the drum corps via bus to all performances.

All participants, staff, and volunteers will be required to be fully vaccinated against COVID-19 prior to arrival.
