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Evolution of Funding in Fintech Companies Latam H1 2021



Q2'21 VC/PE/VD-backed Fintech funding and deals in Latin America remain strong. Deals were up 162% year-over-year (YoY) while funding rises 1,133%.

Latin American Fintech companies raised a total of **US\$ 7,599M** (US\$ 6,328M in equity and US\$ 1,270M in debt financing) in 182 deals* in H1 2021. Of the 182 rounds, 32 were undisclosed.





Evolution of Funding in Fintech Companies

June was the month with the highest financing volume (US \$4,350M) pushed by the mega-round series G of Nubank and the recent investment of JP Morgan Chase in C6 Bank, although **March** was the month with the highest number of deals (46 transactions).



Top Deals by Country Latam H1 2021






Percentage of Deals by Range

72% of the deals have a financing ticket of less than 25 million dollars.




Characteristics of equity round categories




Most Active Investors Latam H1 2021




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
