Annual academic sessions: the latest updates

Our annual academic sessions are less than two months away – and preparations are gathering pace now. The full program is now online (see our website). We thought we will update you on some important matters:

- First of all, keep the dates free: September 12-15 (four days) at the Galadari Hotel Colombo.
- The *full program* is now on our website, but since some minor changes may still happen, make sure that you check for the latest version from time to time.
- The *main component* is between 8.30 am and 4.30 pm, and consists of ceremonial events (the Ceremonial Inauguration on day 1, the Orations on day 4), 12 plenaries, 18 symposia, specialist workshops for consultants, and free paper sessions (both oral and poster presentations). Please note that slots for the specialist workshops is limited (approximately 40), so if you are interested please contact the College office.
- The *remaining component* is in the early-morning (7 8 am) and late-evening (5 -7 pm). There are events focused for senior registrars (3 Communication Skills Workshops in the early-mornings, 3 Senior Registrar Workshops in the late-evening). And there are 18 Teaching Capsules focused for registrars in both early-mornings and late-evenings. <u>Although these are focused on senior registrars or registrars, others can join them too, provided there is enough space</u>. *Slots for Teaching Capsules are limited (approximately 40), so early registration is mandatory, and a payment is required*.
- The *Conference App* will go online soon, for both Android and Apple devices. Check it out! It has many features you will like, and it will help you plan your participation from the comfort of your home.
- The *Conference Website* is now operational. It gives you all the current details, as well as the facility for *online registration* for the conference as well as the Capsules.
- If you are a senior registrar, remember that our Ranji Wikramanayake Research Grants are just for you and the closing date for the current round of applications is August 31 so hurry, because you need the Board of Study approval to apply. Check our website for details (News and Events → Grants).
