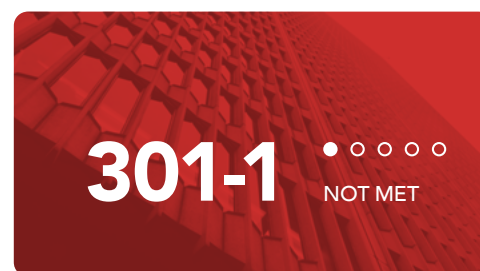


Materials Used

TARGET

Was not met.

COMMENTARY

We produce a large number of drawing and other documents per year which are printed or copied for project use. We try to minimise print and copy quantities through electronic transfers and other means.

PERFORMANCE

Our company's total paper purchase — copier paper and drawing print paper — was 2.016 tonnes.

This represents an increase of 25.37% on last year's figure of 1.608 tonnes which was an increase of 41.4% on the previous year. Note that this also does not cover paper used in our Christchurch office, therefore there would have been a higher result.

IMPACT

According to Trinity College in Western Australia, it takes 17x 20-year-old trees to produce one ton of paper, therefore our consumption equates to 34 trees. Less plan printing and copying equates to less staff unproductive time.

TARGET 2019-2020

We are not satisfied with the result this year and we will be looking at ways to reduce the consumption to the previous years' total. This will involve engaging staff in means of reducing consumption and unnecessary usage.
