Reproductions that are signed, numbered, and labelled as "prints" do not meet the Craft Council of Newfoundland and Labrador's Standard of Quality and are not permitted for sale at Craft Council of Newfoundland and Labrador events or in the Craft Council Shop and Pantry.

To be open to the public on the dates / times they have indicated on this application form.

That access to sites and studios will be free of charge to visitors, unless noted in the listing.

Payment must be received in full and ad content confirmed before the print deadline of April 1, 2022.
