Nothing predicts the future for a child more than the stability of their family life. Our programs provide families and youth with individualized support from staff who are deeply committed to their success. Whether addressing the impacts of generational poverty, trauma, lack of education, or lack of stable resources, CommUnify's programs are designed to build resilience and a better future for our clients.

Services include mentoring and tutoring for high school students and at-risk youth; increasing access to higher education opportunities for first-generation and underrepresented students; health education to prepare teens to become safe, self-sufficient adults, and case management for families struggling with behavioral and emotional wellness.
