Printed copies of the Attribute and Shape cards

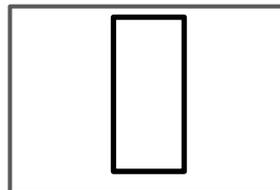
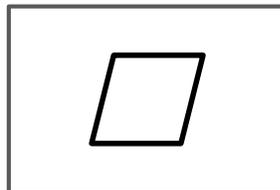
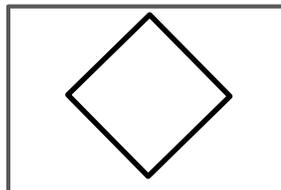
Scissors

## Instructions

1. Print and cut out both the Attribute and Shape card sets.
2. Lay the Attribute cards face down in a single deck and the Shape cards face up, spread out so you can see the shapes on each card.
3. Select an Attribute card. Try to find all of the Shape cards that match the attribute listed.
4. Lay the Attribute card to the side so you do not use it again. Replace the Shape cards.
5. Continue until all of Attribute cards have been used. You can draw copies of the shapes on the Attribute cards.

**Note:** Screen resolution or the device used to print the practice sheet may adjust the shapes' appearances in ways that do not match the key. If students can use measurements to justify their answers, the answers should be considered correct even if the key says otherwise.

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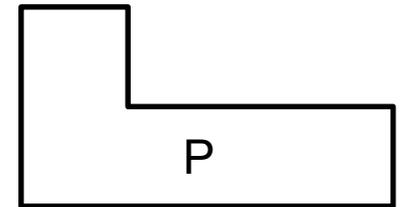
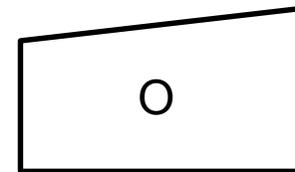
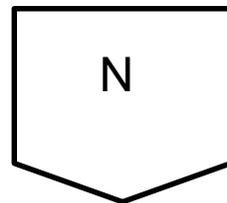
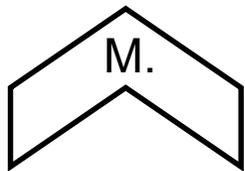
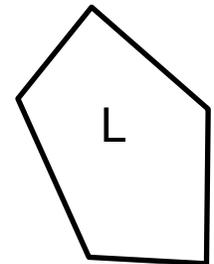
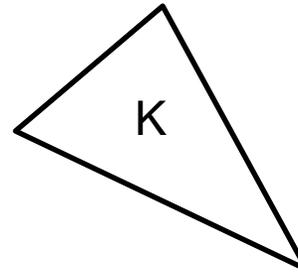
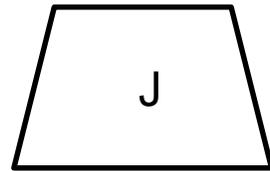
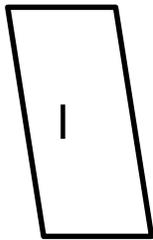
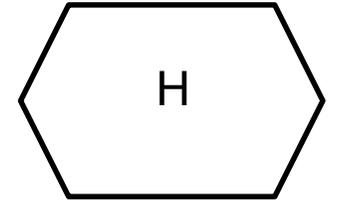
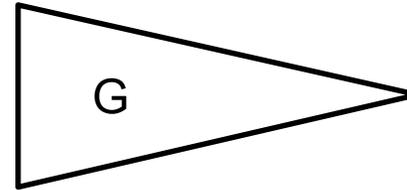
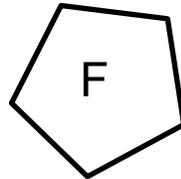
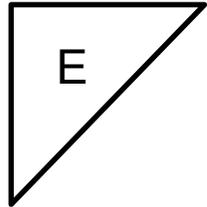
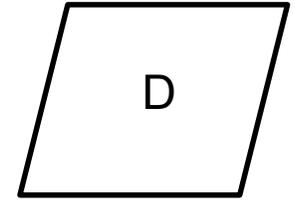
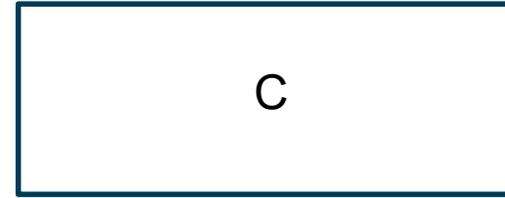
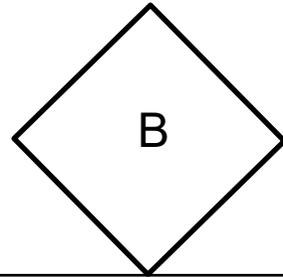
**Square angle:** It can be called a square angle because when a square is put in the corner of the shape, two sides of the square line up with the same sides of the shape-see the black square on the orange square. This term is used with younger children to make sense of what will later be referred to as a 90 degree angle. It is difficult to describe rectangles without addressing the angles.



**Parallel lines:** Two sides that will never touch or intersect if extended. The orange sides are the parallel sides. We can talk about these sides compared to straight railroad tracks if this is helpful. Parallel sides become important when describing trapezoids and parallelograms.

**Congruent:** Same size

**Parallelogram:** Closed 4-sided figure opposite pairs of parallel lines

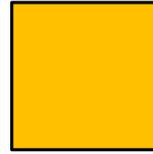
### Part 2

2. For each set of directions, discuss patterns with the shapes. Predict how many shapes it would take for the next larger shape.

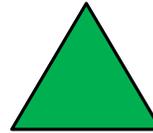
