If unable to print, discuss the process verbally.

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
Instructions

Part 1

Part 2

- 1. Take one each of the pictures (1-5). The child orders the set from largest to smallest.
- 2. Mix up the cards.
- 3. The child reorders the cards from smallest to largest.
- 4. Repeat the process with the bar models and then the numbers.
