Student Citizens is a residential, summer intensive program taking place on Miami University's Oxford campus July 11th – July 23rd.

The program is intended to offer rising high school seniors a general college experience through a balanced mix of academic coursework, social activity, and residential living.

Academically, selected participants will daily:

- Engage college-style coursework under the tutelage of Miami University faculty
- Participate in an intensive seminar on the topic of citizenship
- Receive 3:1 and 1:1 guidance from an academic mentor
- Develop reading, writing, and communication skills
- Practice specific critical thinking and writing skills

Socially, students will experience collegiate life as they:

- Live on campus in a Miami University residence hall
- Enjoy a variety of extracurricular activities
- Connect with peers and mentors in social setting

Student Citizens is college preparatory in nature. As such, participants will maintain connection with program faculty and student mentors throughout the academic year. Student Citizens will provide all summer program graduates with ongoing college admissions support and guidance. Applicants should be prepared to return to Oxford a handful of times throughout the academic year.

Because students will be expected to return to campus throughout the academic year, those rising seniors within 50 miles of Miami's Oxford campus are most encouraged to apply.
