









Please use the following guidelines for where to park at each complex, based on which field you are playing on. I know that sometimes we will be asking you to park at a lot that is a further walk than other lots to your particular field, but we feel that if the lots we suggest are chosen you will have far more success finding a space quickly.

At South Campus especially we will be sharing the facility with other activities. Please be patient, courteous, and give yourself plenty of time to arrive to the facility so that you don't have to worry if it takes a few minutes to find a spot.

South Campus

General notes: there is a lane on the exit side of the Emery/Weiner school for drop-offs/pickups. This is the only place to drop players off. Do not block the main lanes for drop-off.

We are reserving southern half of the back lot at the Emery/Weiner school for baseball. Please do not park there.

The largest lot at the complex is the one at the corner of W. Belfort and S. Main. If you cannot find a space elsewhere you should be able to park here.

Teams playing on fields 1 and 2 should enter the Emery/Weiner school off the Stella Link Entrance. If you are playing on field 2 go straight through to the back, park there, then walk to your field. If you are playing on field 1 go around the back to the exit side and park there.

Teams playing on fields 3W, 3C, or 3E should all park in the softball parking lot, accessible from Timberside Dr. You will then walk through the softball fields to the soccer fields.

Teams playing on field 4 should use the West Belfort lot closest to Stella Link

Teams playing on fields 11N, 11S, or 12 should use the West Belfort lot near the intersection with S. Main.

Teams playing on fields 14N or 14S can park on Timberside Dr. and Link Valley (CHECK THE SIGNS and DON'T block driveways or fire hydrants), or in the Softball lot across the roundabout. No one is to park in the small lot next to the field.

Community Park

General Notes: There is no street parking on Glenn Lakes Lane. There is limited street parking on Lantern Lane. Check the signs, and please make sure you give clearance to any cars exiting the park or school lots to avoid traffic jams.

Teams playing on fields 1, 2, 10 and 11 will want to enter the park from the South, on Glenn Lakes Lane. There is parking there for those fields. Fields 10 and 11 are on the softball fields. If those lots are full, you can continue around to the large lot between field 3 and the baseball fields.

Teams playing on field 3, 4E, 4W, 5E, 5W, 6E, and 6W should park in the large lot between field 3 and the baseball fields.

Teams playing on 9, 8E, 8W, and 7 should enter the park from the north, on Lantern Lane (you can use Lantern Lane Elementary school for your navigation guidance) and park in the first lot there. You can also park at the Elementary school (on the opposite side of the school from the fields). The walk may be longer, but you won't have to be stuck behind everyone leaving the complex!

North Campus – McGovern Park

There is a lot at the park, and another small lot next to field 5 between McGovern and Mark Twain Elementary. There is no street parking on Braes, but there is street parking on Blue Bonnet Blvd. DO NOT PARK at the YMCA.

North Campus - Pershing Middle School

There is a good-sized parking lot accessible on the Stella Link side. There is also legal street parking on Bellefontaine Blvd, though you might have to walk around.
