- d) Certificate from a registered medical practitioner attesting to the general health and physical condition of the applicant. This certificate should not be dated more than six months prior to the closing date of the application.
- e) Two letters of recommendation.
- f) Confirmation Forms signed by the President/Secretary of the applicant's Club (or Bermuda Referees Association) confirming memberships for the last three years.
- g) Letter from a parent/guardian agreeing to accept responsibility for any additional funding [that is, funding over and above the total funding provided by the Bermuda Football Association] which is necessary to maintain the applicant at his/her institution.
- h) All secondary school certificates and transcripts and/or college or university transcripts, together with full details of grades attained in the various subjects up to the end of the current academic year. Official certification of grades is necessary if these do not appear on the actual certificate. The level of pass should be indicated also.
- i) In the case of an applicants studying in the United Kingdom, letters from tutors attesting to the applicant's academic standing are required where grades are not available.
- j) Letter of acceptance at an approved college or university offering the required education or training.
- k) Copy of official statement of estimated costs of tuition and board from the college or university.
- l) Student's Financial Statement.
