Living Accommodations

Participants will live 3 to a cabin which normally holds 12. Each cabin has its own bathroom, and there are additional showerhouse-type bathroom facilities near living spaces for participant use.

Cabins do not have dedicated closets, but each participant has two dresser units made from shelves and cloth boxes. Extra bunks can also be converted into mini closets/dressers.

Laundry

Laundry is available on campus, with 3 washers and dryers available for free.

Desk Space

Each room has a large circular table for folks to work at. There is also ample table and desk space on campus for each student to have a dedicated work zone that they return to. Some participants like to have a single space that they can leave things on and return to later, others like to roam and find work spaces around campus.

In our roommate and intake survey next week, we get these preferences and schedules from each participant to design the living and learning environment.

Dining Hall

The main dining hall has microwaves, toasters, and snacks available for participant use. There are also tables for working.

Community Kitchen

Bradshaw Mountain has a small lounge and community kitchen for participant use.

Commercial Kitchen

For much of the session, the commercial kitchen is only the domain of our wonderful chefs who will prepare 3 meals daily. Occasionally, we'll work with them to teach a workshop or two or put on a community dinner.

Other Common Spaces

LCP – Large, convertible (open air for the first two months, walled for the rest of the session) room with couches, chairs, desks, and tables. A projector and audio/visual

system for coordinated community use.

Wagon Shed – Large, three room building for studying and music practice.

Veranda – Well lit and ventilated room attached to the dining lodge with tables and couches for studying. This is the only room where consumption of alcohol is permitted.

Dining Lodge – A beautiful old lodge-style building where meals are served behind a plexiglass window. A breakfast bar and communal fridge are available at all hours. Coffee is available throughout the day. Many tables are available for studying.

Jack's Hangar – Another small couch and table study room; printer available at all hours.
