WHAT TO DO DURING A LOCAL INCIDENT: FIRE, FLOOD, STORM, ETC

GET READY NOW



Develop a personal incident plan



Pack an emergency kit



Make sure vehicle has fuel



Prepare your house

WHAT TO TAKE



Protective clothing including hat, long sleeve top and pants and sturdy footwear



Prescriptions, medication and toiletries



Important documents. photos, insurance, USB sticks, etc.



Food and water



Phone and charaer. radio



Torch and batteries



Pet needs

WHEN TO LEAVE



When you hear an incident will impact your area



Close windows doors, curtains, turn off gas and appliances



When advised by CFA. SES. DELWP. Vic Police, Radio



Notify family / friends when you leave

LEAVE EARLY



DO NOT rely on electricity to fight fires



DO NOT drive in smoke or flood water
