Important documents, photos, insurance, USB sticks, etc



Food and water



Phone and charger, radio



Torch and batteries



Pet needs

## **WHEN TO LEAVE**



When you hear an incident will impact your area



Close windows, doors, curtains, turn off gas and appliances



When advised by CFA, SES, DELWP, Vic Police, Radio

Notify family / friends when you leave

LEAVE EARLY



**DO NOT** rely on electricity to fight fires



**DO NOT** drive in smoke or flood water
