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Rules for Kerb Side Numbering Permit

General Local Law 2017

The Permit holder must make sure that the work site activities meet Occupational Health & Safety legislation and principals whilst operating on Council assets.

- 1. The permit holder or his agent must make sure pedestrian and vehicle access is not blocked and that nothing annoying happens as a result of the kerb side numbering.
- 2. You must provide Council a copy of your public liability insurance.
- 3. Council bears no responsibility or liability as a result of painting the street numbers on the kerb as requested. Council is not responsible for any costs from the kerb side numbering.
- 4. While painting kerb side numbers, road works signage must be up to warn motorists and pedestrians that you are working in the area and signage must meet Australian Standards.
- 5. Council will accept no responsibility for the maintenance or replacement of the numbers in the event of wear and tear, removal or other damage to the numbers on the kerb faces. This applies to reconstruction of street and footpaths during street maintenance.
- 6. Numbers shall be displayed as follows:
 - (a) Barrier Kerbing on the return of the layback
 - (b) Roll over Kerbing on the top face of the kerbing
- 7. Numbers shall be black and painted on a white background using materials approved by Council.
- 8. Numbers shall be a standard size 80mm in height.
- 9. One number per property only shall be acceptable.
- 10. This permit is not to be used as an approval or recommendation by Council for any work done by the operator. Any knowledge to the above shall result in immediate withdrawal of the permit.
- 11. Council can ask you to remove the numbering, at your cost, for any numbering not of acceptable standard.
- 12. Council does not demand this service, the permit holder needs to give documents to each client stating this. Any harassment or bullying approach will result in the permit being cancelled.
