Danegrove has always had a strong tradition of nurturing caring, confident & empowered children. However following our INSET with Dr Neil Hawkes on Values Based Education we have made it even more explicit.

Each month the whole school explores a different value through;
*PSHE lessons that are planned and differentiated carefully according to our whole school programme and the needs of the class.

*Whole school displays (see left)

* Classroom displays (a sample of which are on show on our website!)

*Assemblies

*Values songs (such as the one sung by our school choir-Glee Club -on our website!)

*Book studies- such “Billy Goats Fluff” exploring the values that are shown through the plot and characters.

*Linked with all other curriculum areas where possible particularly co-operation activities where the children are taught how to work well as a team.

*Empowering the children to recognise

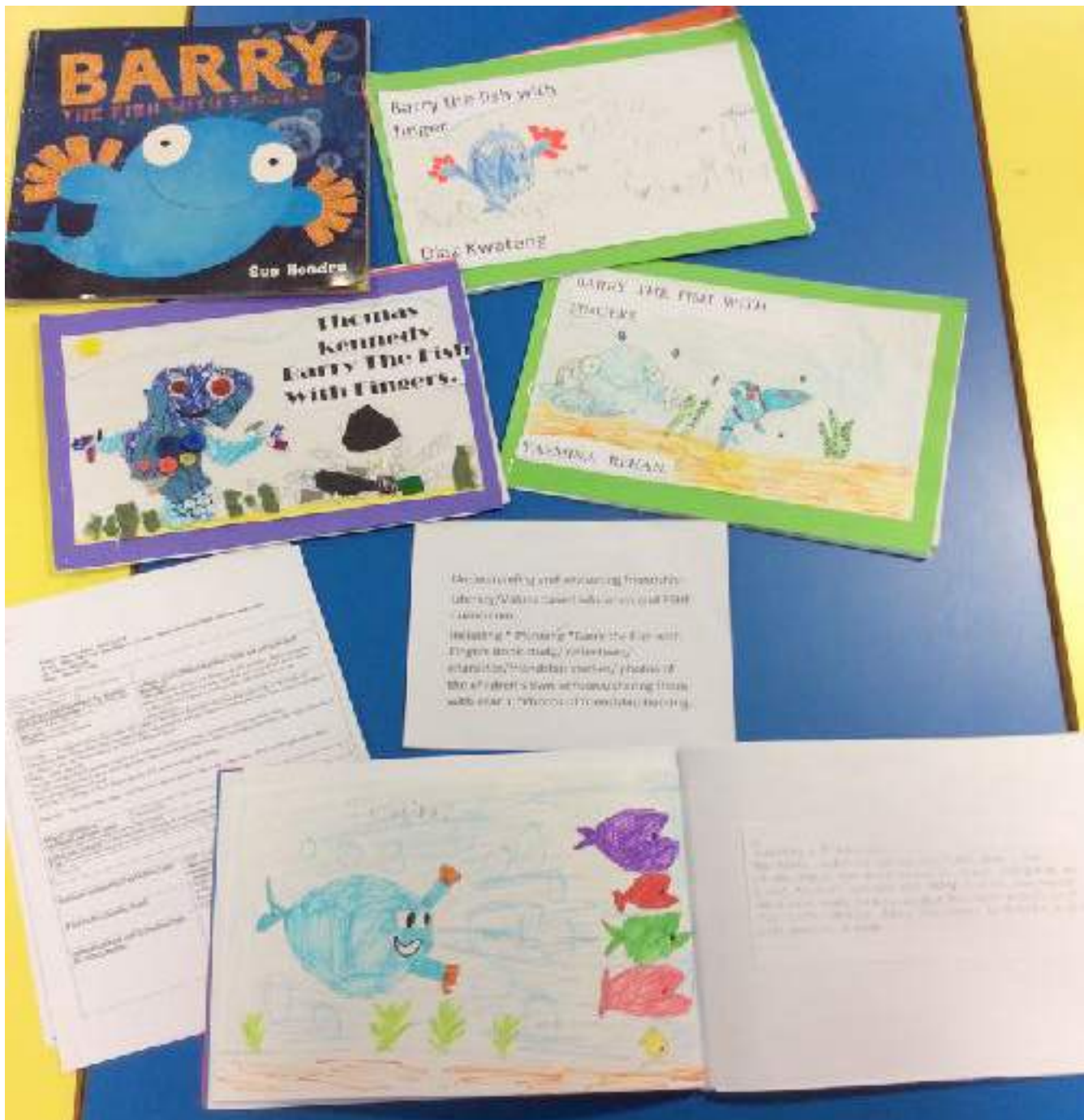
- a) **“What Makes A Good Human Being”** and identify what they value in each other and themselves- for example, “what kind things we notice others have shown display” which the children add to!
- b) **Empower children to recognise how they can become a better learner.**
Including reflecting on their targets, how well they think they have done and explain what helped them to achieve.

***Certificates-** each week staff select pupils to receive a certificate and feel valued for a area that they have shown excellence.

***Science links with Sex Education & Our Changing Bodies.**
We follow the latest guidance from the PSHE association and Barnet Schools wellbeing programme. We use the updated and approved BBC 4 materials and inform parents as much as possible.

* **Learning mentor and Medical room** providing essential Support for children, particularly the most vulnerable

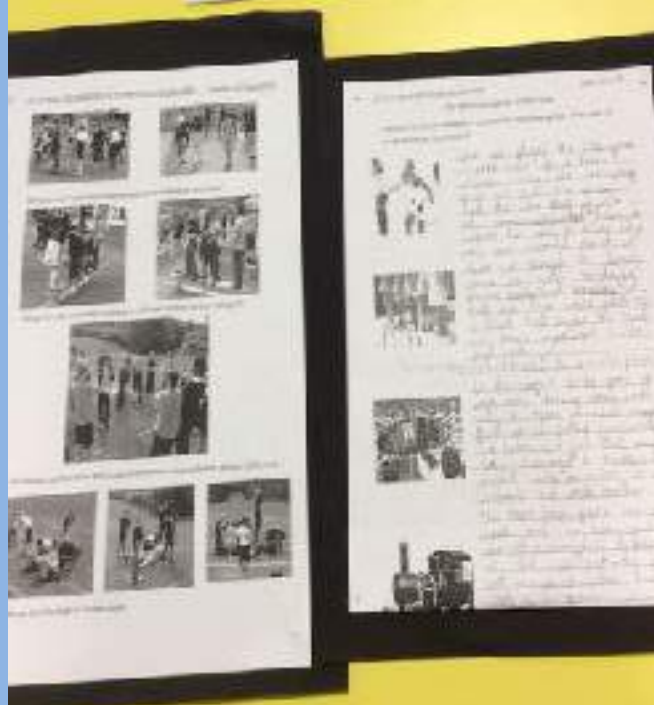
