



ISSUE-BASED LESSONS

Prefer something simpler or have an existing go-to lesson plan? OPi can be easily integrated into any lesson to meet your preferences and complement your teaching style with minimal effort and prep-work.

Resources required:

- Students' personal mobile devices with Internet access
- Desktop/laptop
- Projector

Lesson objectives:

- Empower students to take the lead in guiding discussions.
- Encourage students to become more sensitive to the nuances in the world around them.
- Cultivate empathy and perspective-taking when dealing with different views on issues that matter to them.

Lesson Plan

An OPPI poll will be created by the teacher and be issued to the class prior to the discussion.

Students will take some time to input their responses in the poll.

The class will be divided into groups of four to five students each. They will then share their first thoughts on the topic at hand within their groups.

The teacher will flash the results of the poll on screen and go through the data collected with students.

In their groups, students will discuss these results. After which, the circles share their learnings, and the teacher will wrap up the session.
