School Closure from Monday 4th January

First of all, we would like to wish you all a Happy and Healthy New Year.

As you are aware, the school will remain closed to the majority of children from 4th January until further notice (to be reviewed before 18th January).

From home, children will be able to access home learning via Seesaw. Daily, the Year 6 team will upload the day's activities, with supporting lesson presentations and videos, onto Seesaw. Children should complete this work in their homework/Maths book and then upload them to Seesaw (see timings below). Please contact the office if your child needs their Seesaw code.

We strongly encourage all children to adhere to the timetable of tasks set. E.g. Maths between 9-10.30, English from 11-12. The teachers will be available on Seesaw to answer questions about those lessons if the children need additional support. Answers to Maths tasks will be shared with the children by 10.30 so, they can self mark the answers before we check them.

- Please take a picture of the morning work (Maths and English) and upload daily onto Seesaw (by 12pm) to be checked and marked.
- Please upload the afternoon tasks by 3pm. This will allow us to mark all of the work by 5pm.
- Continue using Mathletics, Bug Club and Times table Rockstar.
- Please continue to practise your times tables and division facts.
- Read every day for a minimum of 30 minutes and complete a book study task on Friday.

We are so proud of all of the children and of the progress that they have made so far this academic year. Please help your child to continue with this progress by ensuring that they complete their daily home learning tasks.
