## Maths:

For your homework this week we would like you to think about division, and sharing equally, like we did in school this week.

**Must:** Divide the numbers below by 2, and write them down.

4, 8, 6, 2, 10, 12, 16, 14, 12,

**Should:** Divide the numbers below by 2 and write them down:

4, 8, 6, 2, 10, 12, 16, 14, 12, 18, 20

Divide the numbers below by 5 and write them down:

5, 10, 20, 15, 25, 30

**Could:** Divide the numbers below by 5 and write them down:

5, 10, 20, 15, 25, 30, 40, 35, 50

Divide the numbers below by 3 and write them down:

9, 6, 12, 3, 15, 21, 18, 27, 33, 30

**Ext:** Can you divide all numbers by 2? Why?

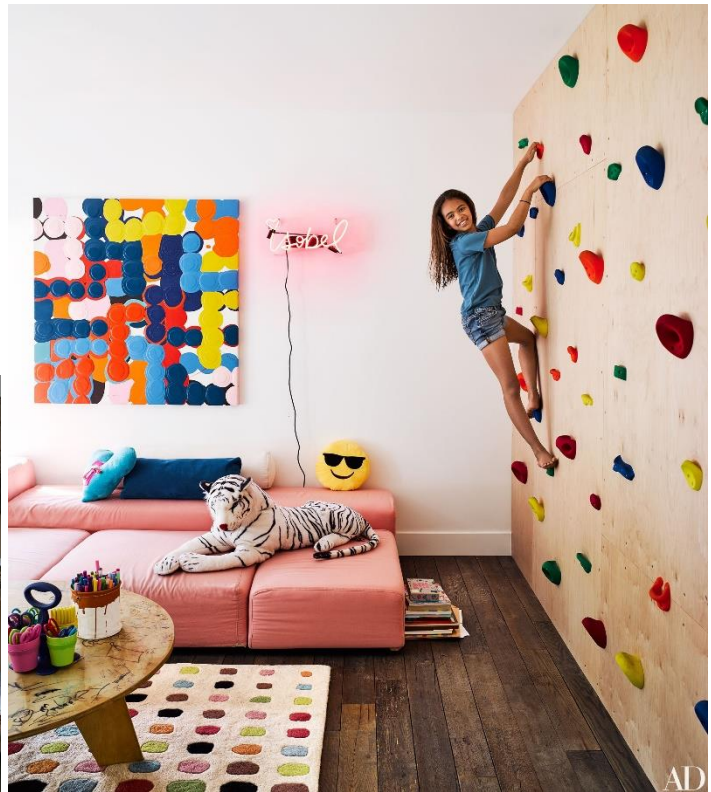
As you're listening, think about what the moral of the story is, what is it trying to tell you?
