

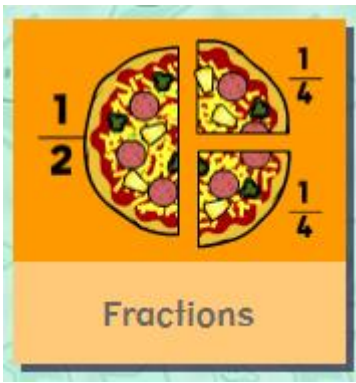
Maths:

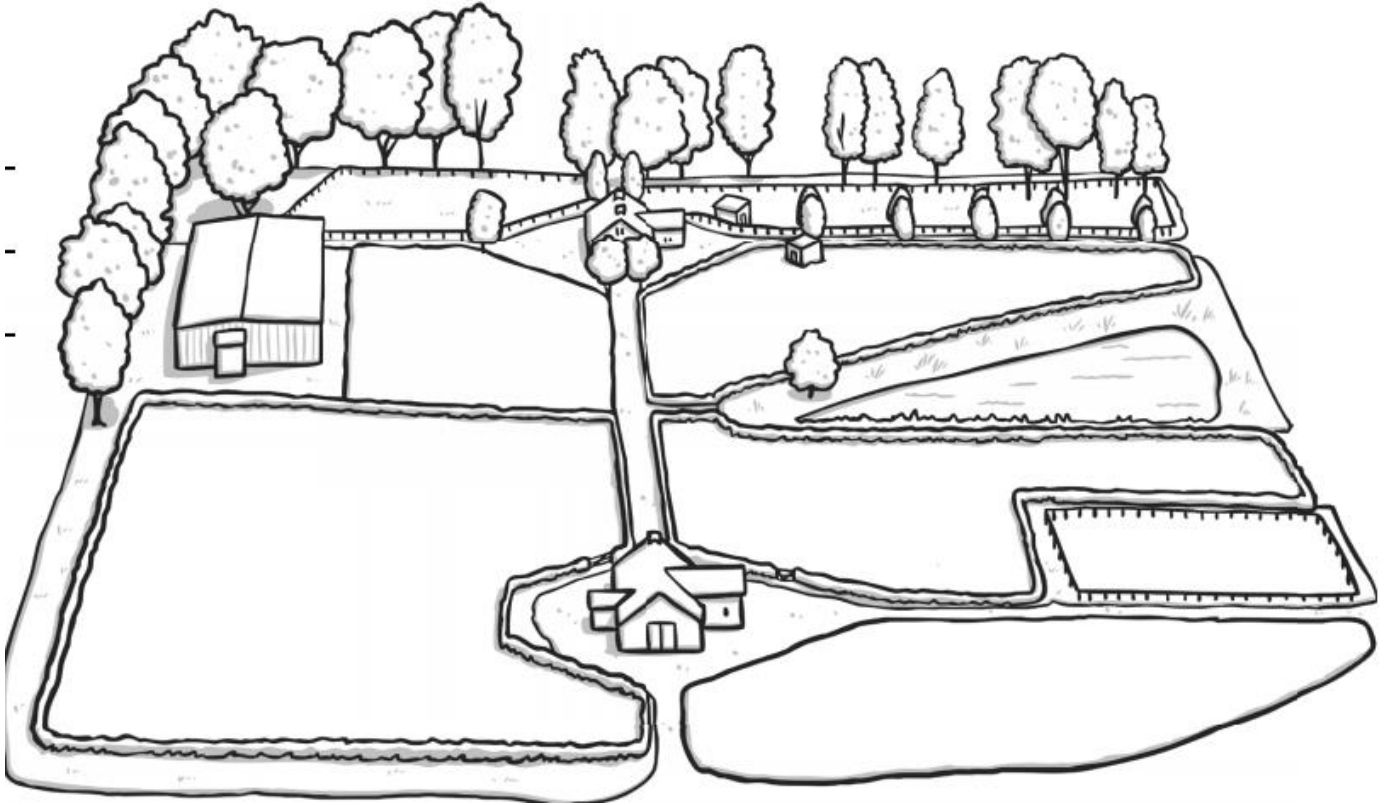
