Homework should be completed and uploaded to SeeSaw before the following Wednesday each week.

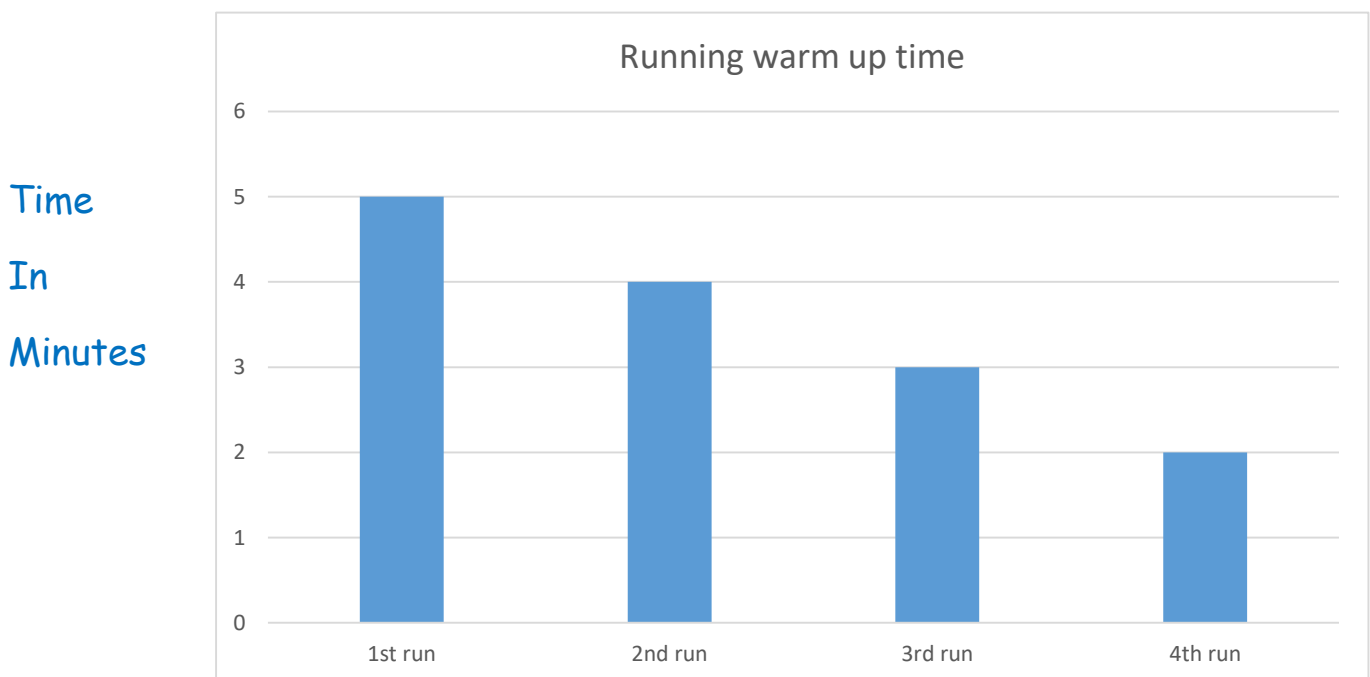
Maths/ Physical Education:

In preparation for next week's sports day we would like you to invent your own warm up/ exercise routine. This could be a jog around the garden or park, a number of star jumps, or even an egg and spoon race with your family.

You are then going to use a mobile phone / computer or tablet to time yourself completing your activity.

You will need to create a chart like the one below, showing the time it took you to complete your activity.

You need to give your chart a title, and labels.



Then, upload a photo or video of you completing your exercise, and a photo of your times written on a bar chart.

English:

Could: As above including a design for your paper, with set text boxes, expanded noun phrases, a minimum of 8 relevant points.

You can type or write your assignment.
