## Maths: CLOCKS

This week we would like you to take your time practising and honing the skills of telling the time. We have worked on this in class so you have a good stepping stone for your practise.

**Must:** Telling the time to o'clock, half past, quarter past and quarter to, recognising this in both digital and analogue format.

**Should:** Telling the time to o'clock, half past, quarter past, quarter to, as well as 10 past, 20 past, 10 to and 20 to, recognising this in both digital and analogue format.

**Could:** Telling the time to 5 minute increments such as 10:05, and 11:10, recognising this in both digital and analogue format.
