Key Information

- Please ensure that your child is at school on time. The soft start routine will begin from 8.40am, any children who enter school after 8:50am are considered late. Home-time is at 3:30pm. Each year group has designated class and parent zone. Any children not collected at this time will be taken briefly to the area by the office and then sent to play scheme where a charge will be accrued.
- Children are encouraged to bring in a healthy snack that they can eat at morning play. Fruit or vegetables are ideal, as are cheese, crackers or a small sandwich. Please note that we are a nut free school (therefore **no products with nuts** inside are allowed). NO chocolate, crisps or sweets.
- **P.E kit: Children come to school IN their PE kit on PE days**
  - plain white tshirt (with logo if possible)
  - plain navy shorts or leggings or joggers
  - trainers (appropriate for sport) or black plimsolls
  - Danegrove jumper or cardigan or fleece

No earrings during P.E. - you must take them out at home before school or they will be covered with masking tape in school.

PE days = Wed + Fri = 3FR and 3JC      Thurs + Fri = 3SC

• **School Uniform:**

Black school shoes - NO boots, trainers

Hair accessories must be uniform coloured (navy or white)

NO jewellery e.g. bracelets, necklaces (except under religious beliefs e.g. Kara bracelet - Sikhism)

NO leggings only school trousers or skirt and tights

**Homework:** (in accordance with government legislation)

- Homework will be issued on Fridays and children's responses need to be uploaded to the Seesaw activity by Wednesday. Homework consists of; Literacy (usually linked to our topic), Reading, Spellings/Vocabulary and Maths (this will sometimes be on Mathletics). This will always be linked to the work that is completed in class each week. We shall also ask for the children to continue learning their times tables.
- Daily reading practice of approximately 20 minutes is the year group target. **We strongly recommend that parents regularly spend time listening to their children read at home and allow some discussion time to help them develop their ideas, vocabulary and understanding.** Children can read anything they wish, but a variety of choice is recommended i.e. magazines, story books, poems, encyclopedias, diaries, letters etc. Please encourage your child to discuss their choice of text with you, answering questions, thinking about the text (its main features and content) as well as its meaning.
- The homework letter will be uploaded to Seesaw and the school website. Children will not be given a printed copy unless requested.
