

# YESTERDAY TODAY FOREVER ENDOWMENT FUNDS FOR OUR FUTURE

The St. Dominic Endowment Fund is important to the well being of the church and school by providing a stable investment pool from which to draw funds that support Parish Life, Education and Facilities. Cumulative income distributions from the endowment fund over the past fifteen years totaled **over \$3,000,000**, and this is expected to increase as our endowment continues to grow.

Thanks to the many new funds and the 2003 Capital Campaign the value has increased to **\$4,774,338** as of December, 2020.

The endowment is held in professionally managed assets – stocks and bonds – and represents the living legacy of generous benefactors who have chosen to give of their financial assets to sustain St. Dominic’s traditions and future. The Fund is invested as a whole, but individually managed with ensuing profits used to fund various individual purposes.
