Colores del Sol wine is crafted in a distinct style, combining cutting-edge winemaking skills with the authenticity and singular charm of the Malbec grape. The Colores del Sol Malbec is sourced exclusively from the Luján de Cuyo district within Mendoza, one of Argentina's most prestigious wine growing regions. At elevations reaching 3,500 feet, the vineyards in the Luján de Cuyo are among the highest, driest, and sunniest in the world. This elevation allows the area to remain cool while the grapes bask in bright, pure sunlight. This inspired the wine's name, Colores del Sol which translates to 'Colors of the Sun'.

VITICULTURE:

The entire Mendoza region, including the Luján de Cuyo district, is situated in the rain shadow of the Andes Mountains to the west. The grapes in this area enjoy consistently bright, warm days, while being chilled by the mountain air in the evenings. This diurnal variation translates into greater complexity of flavor and aroma in the finished wine.

Irrigation of the vineyards comes from the various rivers which run down from the Andes including the largest river, the Mendoza. The region that are among the highest elevation with more sun in one of the driest growing conditions in the world. Our location offers a unique combination of wind, sun and irrigation from the snow melt of the Andes, creating a rich, ripe Cabernet Sauvignon.

TASTING NOTES:

This wine offers a rich, ripe Cabernet Sauvignon brimming with dark chocolate, roasted cherry and currant flavors. The medium oak tannins provide a long balanced finish. Ideally to be paired with pork meats, poultry dishes with creamy sauces and semi-hard cow cheeses.
