Winemaker Notes: The 2017 Syrah shows bright aromas along with great structure. Our vines were farmed meticulously, maintaining the proper number of clusters for each individual shoot. This technique produces a very intense wine that captures the flavors of our site.

Classic aromas of boysenberry and cherry with a smoky accent dominate the wine, while cranberry, blackberry flavors and refined tannins round out the flavors and finish.

Optimum storage conditions: constant temperatures 55 to 58°F, darkness Aging potential: For extended aging under ideal conditions, consume within 3-10 years of bottling date.
