

Understanding your bill.

Electricity, Water and Thermal Energy Metered Services

As a customer of Metergy Solutions, you will receive a bill statement similar to the sample outlined below. This sample statement explains the line items you may see on your first bill, depending on the services delivered.







- Your **Account Number** identifies you as a unique Metergy customer. Please reference this number when making a payment and setting up your online account at MyMetergySolutions.com.
- The **Statement date** is the date that your bill was issued. The **Due Date** is when your bill payment must be made by and the **Amount Due** is the total amount you must by the due date.
- Your **Summary of Charges** is where you will see your current charges, your previous bill amount, your most recent payment, and any balances (if applicable).
- The **Bill Breakdown** will display the cost breakdown for each of your services. Your electricity, water and/or thermal details will be on page 2 of your bill.
- Message Center will help you stay informed. Metergy will share important updates here.




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- **Electricity** is the cost of the electricity supplied to the service address during this billing period.
- Electricity delivery charges are the costs of delivering electricity from generating stations to your utility and then to your home or business. This also includes the costs associated with providing metered services to your home or business. A portion of these charges are fixed and do not change from month to month. The rest are variable and increase or decrease depending on the amount of electricity you use.
- 8 Regulatory Charges are the costs of administering the wholesale electricity system and maintaining the reliability of the provincial grid.
- Metergy is not the provider of electricity, water, and/or thermal energy and is not required to collect and remit HST on these charges. The ¹HST amount represents an amount that was payable by your building to the provider of electricity, water, and/or thermal energy and not an amount that Metergy is collecting as HST. Metergy is merely recovering, on behalf of your building, an amount equal to the HST that was payable by your building in relation to your electricity, water, and/or thermal energy consumption.
- Water and Sewage Usage is the cost of supplying and delivering water and related services to your home or business and other charges from your local water utility provider.
- Water and thermal delivery charges are for the cost of metered services supplied. Within delivery, the administration fee covers the costs of installing, maintaining and reading the submeters, as well as costs related to billing, customer care, collections and general administrative services.
- The **Read Type** explains how your electricity usage data was collected for the billing period. 'ACT' indicates that the read was based on actual consumption. 'EST' will appear if your consumption was estimated.



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- Thermal Usage is the cost of supplying and delivering thermal energy to heat or cool your home or business. Your bill may show a heating charge or cooling charge, or both, depending on the usage in the month.
- The **service setup charge** is a one-time administration charge applied to new accounts.
- New customers are required to pay a security deposit unless they meet the security deposit waiver conditions outlined in the Conditions of Service found at MetergySolutions.com. The deposit is applied to your account over six equal monthly installments, appearing as a Deposit Installment Plan.
