Tip 1

Resist printing stuff

Printing off copies of designs and scribbling on them just isn't needed anymore now online proofing tools are available.

And ultimately, it isn't possible when you're working from home.

You can use an online proof that you can scratch, circle, strike, highlight, measure or basically do anything you want to. It's exactly the same as printing it off but with one massive difference.

You don't use any paper or ink.

Oh wait, sorry, there's another one too.

You don't have a single physical object that can only be on one desk at a time.

If printed designs or documents are sat with you for proofing, They're not with someone else, which is totally inefficient and isolated.

Sending emails for everyday questions and answers is on the way out.

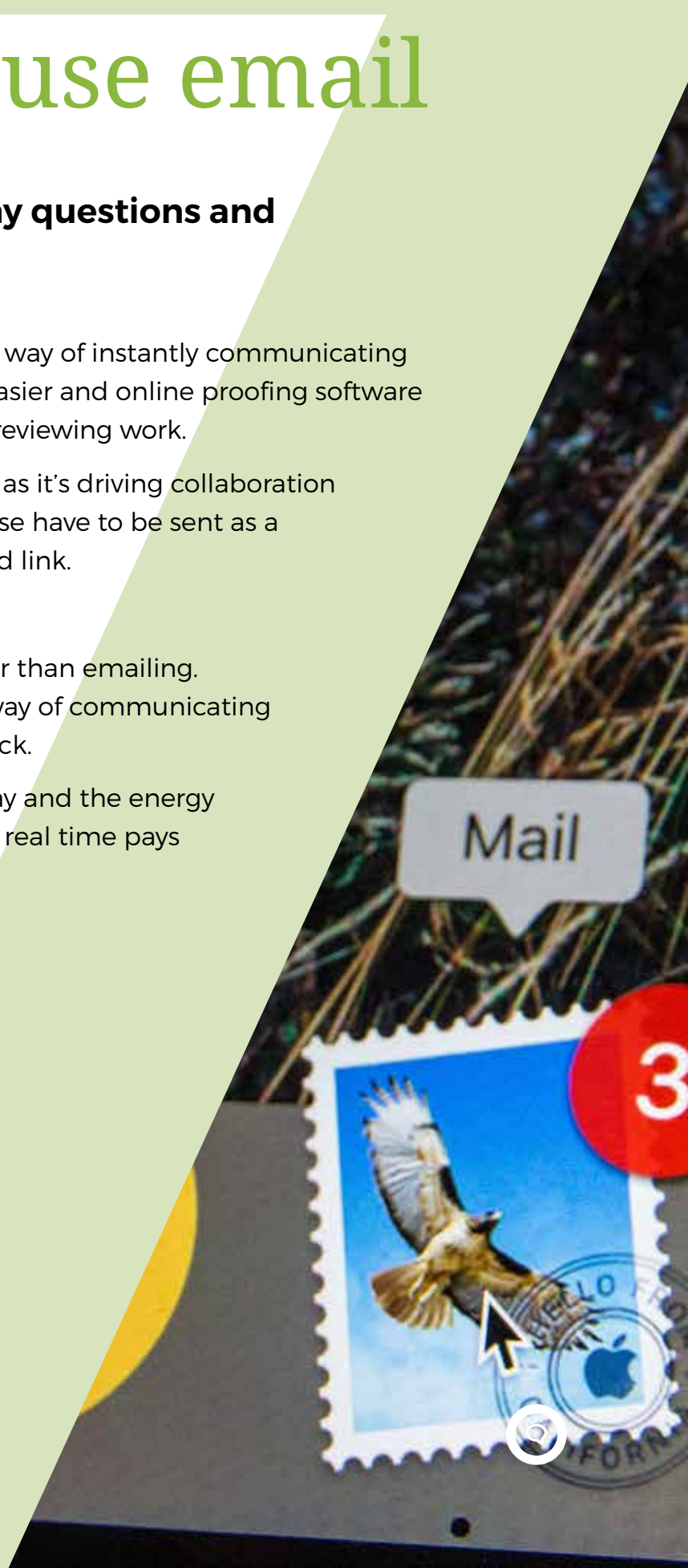
The Slack, Messenger and WhatsApp way of instantly communicating to individuals or groups is so much easier and online proofing software provides the same easy platform for reviewing work.

Get more used to commenting rather than emailing. Uploading not attaching. It's a new way of communicating but once you do it, you won't look back.

Creative journeys are reduced this way and the energy and clarity you create from talking in real time pays huge dividends.



Tip 5

Forget about storage and file transfers

Online proofing software such as GoProof looks after all the sharing and caring of your media files. It's awesome.

If you have to access internal servers, folders and systems over flaky VPNs from home, stress levels rise and anxiety kicks in as your performance deteriorates.

Using intake file uploaders and Adobe Creative Cloud extensions, files are quickly uploaded to the proofing cloud and made available for everyone to access and collaborate on through a secure website.

Extra images such as logo replacements can be uploaded through the comments by collaborators - so no emailing or Dropbox links needed - ensuring there's one central place for all content to be viewed.

Tip 6

Use reminders and deadlines
