Personal data management Policy

1. Scope and purpose of the policy

ProovStation is a simplified joint stock company duly incorporated in France under number 842 788 069 at the Trade and Companies Register of Lyon with a share capital of €50,010, with its registered offices located at 99 rue du Président Edouard Herriot, 69002 Lyon, FRANCE. ProovStation is responsible for the processing of your personal information collected on its website.

The overall objective of this Policy is to provide you information on :

- The collection and the use of your personal data;
- Your rights in relation with the processing of your personal data by ProovStation;
- All the measures implemented by ProovStation to ensure the security of your personal data.

The Privacy Policy applies to all ProovStation services, including but not limited to, meetings and calls with Sales Department or every other ProovStation service delivery.

The Privacy Policy shall be updated in accordance with legislation changes or with the development of ProovStation's activities. We therefore suggest you to check this page from time to time to notice any possible changes.

2. Collection and use of your data

Under this Policy, the term "data" means any personal information allowing the identification of a person visiting the website www.proovstation.com, the prospects and customers of ProovStation's solution.

Your personal data are collected and processed by ProovStation for the purpose described below.

Business development and commercial relation

When you visit our website and fill the contact form, ProovStation may collect and process the following data :

- Personal identification data as name, surname and telephone number;
- Electronic identification data as email address;

- Information related to working environment as company name, job position, etc.

We may also collect all these information from your business card if you acknowledge to give it to any ProovStation's employee.

These data are gathered in an automated file (CRM) and processed by ProovStation only for marketing and business development. They will be used to follow your demand for booking a test of the Station.

These data will be kept for 3 years from the date of the last contact with you.

ProovStation's website is hosted in data centers located in the European Union.

3. Data transmission to a third party

ProovStation may transfer the collected data to :

- (i) Its partner, affiliates, suppliers, subcontractor in relation to the provision of ProovStation's services and in accordance with the confidentiality obligations between ProovStation and its commercial partners;
- (ii) Comply with in force law or final justice decision;
- (iii) Ensure and protect people security or ProovStation solution security.

4. Data protection and Security

ProovStation is responsible for the security of the collected data and implements all necessary measure to maintain the confidentiality, integrity and availability of these data. With the application of a need-to-know principle, the access to the personal data is strictly regulated to ProovStation employees who need it to do their job. They are subject to a confidential obligation in accordance with their employment contract.

5. Exercise of your rights

ProovStation undertakes to comply strictly with the provisions of EU Reg. No 679/2016 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 27 April 2016 on the protection of individuals with regard to the processing of personal data (the "GDPR"), and more generally with any regulations applicable to the processing of personal data. In accordance with the in-force law, you have the right of access, rectification, erasure, portability, restrict processing of your data collected and processed by ProovStation.
