## Board Policy 110-1

### CODE OF ETHICS FOR DIRECTORS OF MATANUSKA ELECTRIC ASSOCIATION, INC.

#### Directors must:

- 2. Represent the interest of all members of the Association, and not personal or special interests.
- 3. Respect confidentiality of information designated by the Association as such and keep confidential any and all information relating to discussions at its executive sessions, including but not limited to any and all materials, reports, or correspondence related thereto, unless compelled by legal process to disclose such information.
- 4. Abide by rules and regulations of the Association, including but not limited to the Association's Articles of Incorporation and Bylaws, and Board policies, with particular emphasis on the Conflict of Interest provisions contained in the Bylaws.
- 5. Support and respect the majority decisions of the Board.
- 6. Not use a Board position for personal gain and disqualify themselves from participation in a decision that may have a financial effect upon personal interests.
- 7. Director Disclosures, under this policy, shall be made public during the regular monthly Board of Directors' meetings.

The Association reserves the right to determine if this Code of Ethics has been breached. Any such breach may be addressed by remedies available by law or in the Bylaws, including but not limited to adopting a resolution expressing disapproval of the conduct of the Board member, private or public reprimand by the Board, or removal of a Board member in accordance with Bylaws.
