September 17, 1940 - January 25, 2014



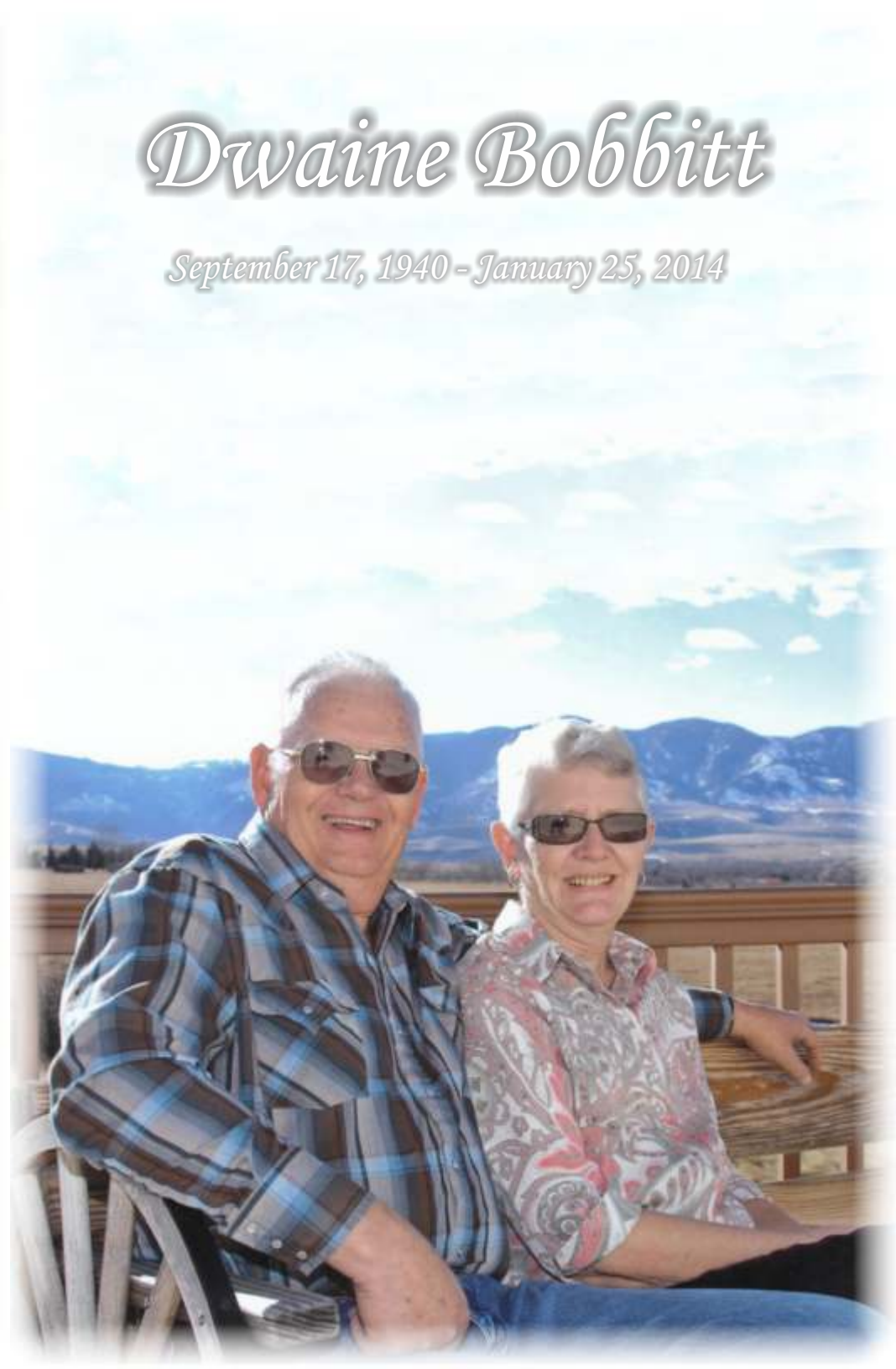
Dwaine Bobbitt, 73, of Sheridan passed away at his home on Saturday, January 25, 2014.
