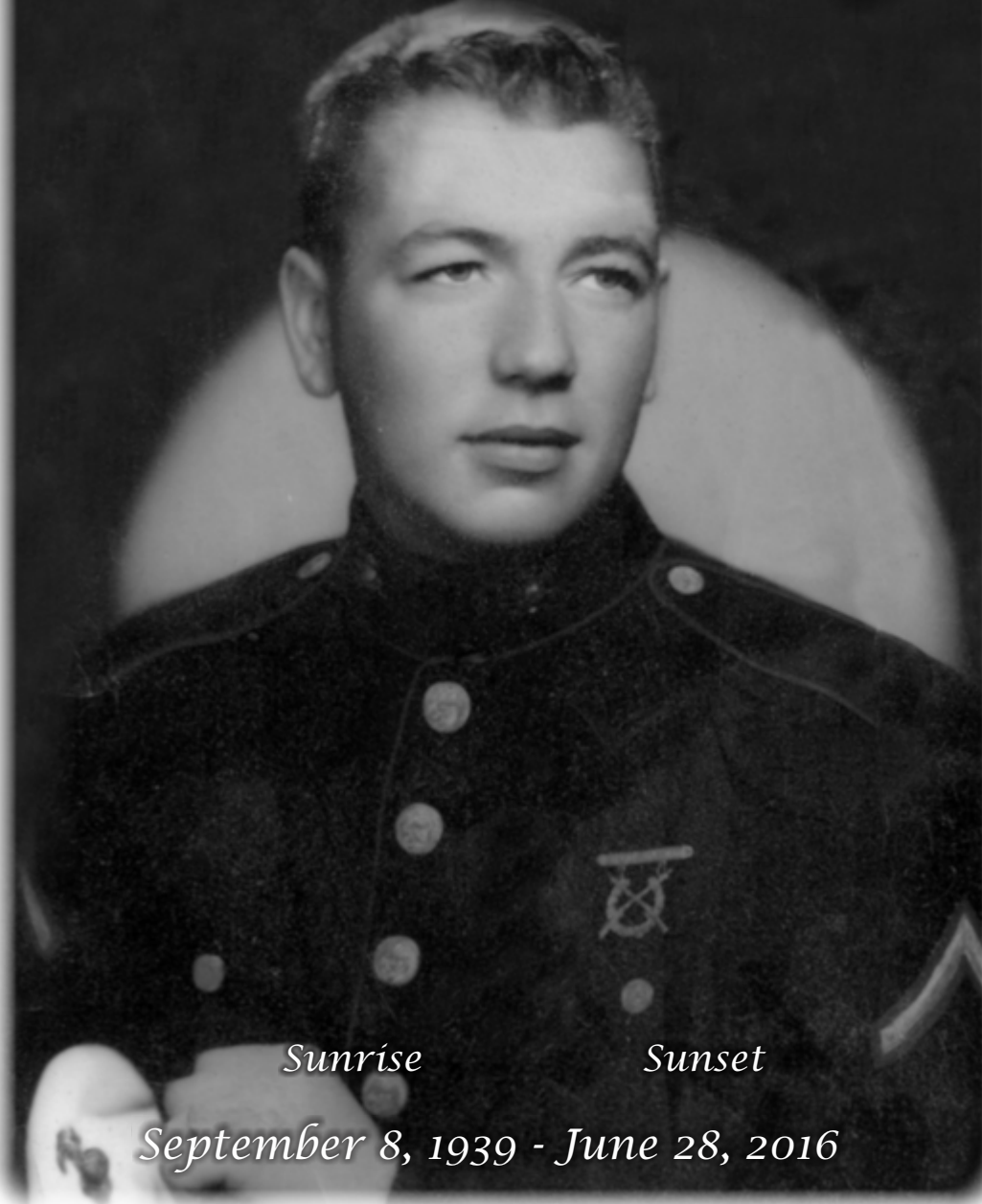


In Loving Memory Of
