<ul> <li>Device to join on Zoom</li> <li>At least 3 TP tubes</li> <li>White cardstock or other heavy drawing paper</li> <li>Colorful pencils and/or markers</li> <li>Scissors</li> <li>Colorful construction paper, including gray, pink, white, orange, black, and yellow</li> <li>Scotch tape</li> <li>Liquid glue</li> <li>Pencil or pen</li> <li>Pink pipe cleaner</li> <li>Cardboard or heavy cardstock, at least 11x14"</li> <li>Yarn</li> <li>Felt, at least 3x5"</li> <li>2 black beads and 1 pink bead</li> <li>Paper plate</li> <li>Acrylic or tempera paint: Brown, red, black, and white</li> <li>Paintbrush</li> <li>Water cup</li> <li>Paper bowl</li> <li>Green felt or paper at least 3x6"</li> </ul>	Optional items include googly eyes, thread, ribbon, and celery

Day 1	Seeing the Forest and the Trees	□ 1-2 TP tubes □ Watercolor paper (a few sheets) □ Tempera or acrylic paint set □ Paintbrush(es) □ Water cup □ Scissors	□ Tubes will be cut to about 1.5" in length and your child should have at least 5 (though they may not use all 5) □ This project could get messy! Be sure to protect your child's work surface and provide paper towels or rags □ Gather supplies
Day 2	Awesome Possums	□ 1 TP tube □ Acrylic or tempera paint: black, white □ Paintbrush(es) □ Water cup □ Construction paper: Pink, white □ Scissors □ Masking or scotch tape and/or liquid glue □ Pink pipe cleaner □ Pencil or pen □ Optional: small googly eyes	<ul> <li>□ This project could get messy! Day 3	Funny Bunnies	□ Socks! □ Scissors (sharp enough to cut the sock material cleanly) □ Rice for stuffing (or an alternative of your choice) □ Twine or string □ Ribbon(s) □ A dark marker or acrylic or tempera paint (for eyes, nose, mouth) □ Tape (optional) □ Googly eyes (optional)	☐ Gather supplies



Day 4	Owls	□ Paper plate □ Acrylic or tempera paint: Brown and white □ Paintbrush(es) □ Water cup □ Colorful construction paper (orange, black, and yellow for conventional colors) □ Scissors □ Pencil □ Liquid glue □ Optional: Ribbon for hanging; celery for scallop stamp pattern	<ul> <li>□ This project could get messy! Day 5	Mushrooms	□ At least 1 TP tube □ At least 1 paper bowl □ Green felt or paper □ Acrylic or tempera paint, especially red and white □ Paintbrush(es) □ Water cup □ Liquid glue □ Scissors	<ul> <li>□ This project could get messy!
