



# EXPRESSIVE ARTS (Session A) Class Supply List

## General Supplies:

- Pencil
- Scotch tape
- Washable markers
- Crayons
- Scissors
- Glue stick
- 15 sheets of white paper
- 5 sheets of white cardstock

## Specialty Supplies:

- DIY Art Journal Supplies:
  - 6 sheets of watercolor paper - at least 8x10 inches and no larger than 9x12 inches
  - 2 pieces of cardboard 9x12 inches
  - 24 inches yarn
- Hole puncher \*
- 2-3 styrofoam plates or sheets
- Acrylic or tempera paint set
- Paint brush
- 1 paper plate (easy to fold)
- 4+ rubber bands
- 1 empty paper towel tube
- Rectangular tissue box or similar

**NOTE:** Items marked with an asterisk \* are NOT in the supply kit!





# Supply Lists & Prep by Session

## Session 1 - DIY Art Journal

### Supplies

- 2 pieces of cardboard 9x12"
- 6 sheets of watercolor paper - at least 8x10 inches and no larger than 9x12 inches
- 4 sheets of white paper
- Hole puncher \*
- 24 inches yarn
- Scissors
- Pencil
- Coloring supplies

### Preparation before Class

- Gather materials
- Your child may need your help with the hole puncher!

## Session 2 - Printmaking

### Supplies

- DIY Art Journal
- 2-3 styrofoam plates or other flat styrofoam
- Pencil
- Acrylic or tempera paint set
- Paint brush
- Water cup \*

- Be sure to protect your child's work surface and provide cleanup materials!

## Session 3 - Mask Art

### Supplies

- 1 paper plate (easy to fold)
- Scissors
- Hole puncher \*
- 18 inches of yarn or string
- Acrylic or tempera paint set
- Paint brush
- Water cup \*

- Be sure to protect your child's work surface and provide cleanup materials!

### Supplies

- DIY Art Journal
- Pencil

## Session 5 - DIY Ukulele

### Supplies

- Rectangular tissue box or similar
- 4+ rubber bands
- 1 empty paper towel tube
- Scissors
- Scotch tape

- Ideally our box will have a hole like a tissue box. You can help your child prepare by cutting a hole if their box does not already have one.
