

## **Briefing for Police and Crime Commissioner**

### **Topic: OPCVC Risk Register**

### **Purpose of briefing**

To describe the use of the OPCVC Risk Register.

### **Background**

The Office of the Police, Crime and Victims' Commissioner (OPCVC) has a Risk Register that is reviewed regularly by the OPCVC Senior Leadership Team (SLT) and presented to the Joint Audit Committee for a quality assurance review of changes.

### **Current Issues**

The reassurance function of the Joint Audit Committee is partially fulfilled through the review of the OPCVC Risk Register. The changes to the Register are determined and influenced by the prevailing and emerging circumstances (locally, regionally and nationally) and by activities that are implemented/planned to mitigate the risks described.

### **Decisions Needed**

The only decisions needed are taken by the OPCVC SLT and relate to inclusion/deletion of risks or changes to the risk scores based on activities undertaken to mitigate the risks described.

### **Partnership Involvement**

There is no partnership involvement in the compilation of the OPCVC Register but the risk inclusion/deletion and changes to risk scores are influenced by partner activities.

### **Police Involvement**

There is no police involvement in the compilation of the Register but the risk inclusion/deletion and changes to risk scores are influenced by police activities.

### **People to Meet**

Members of the OPCVC SLT attend a Joint Audit Committee where the OPCVC Risk Register is on the agenda.
