Request: The PCVC and Acting PCVC to approve the County Durham Vision 2035

Title: County Durham Vision 2035

Executive Summary:

The County Durham Vision is owned by the County Durham Partnership, and signed up to be members collectively and individually. It sets the overall direction for the Partnership and its members for the period to 2035.

The document contains a vision:

Our vision for 2035 is that County Durham is a place where there are more and better jobs, people live long and independent lives and our communities are well connected and supportive of each other

....and there are three headline ambitions:

- More and better jobs
- People live long and independent lives
- Connected communities

Below each of these is a series of specific objectives, which are consistent with the outcomes and some of the priorities in the 2018 Police, Crime and Victims' Plan. Those relating to community safety include reference to the safety of young people, support for victims, safe towns and cities, tackling crime and anti-social behaviour (ASB), addressing the underlying causes of crime, encouraging community cohesion, problem-solving, and activities to prevent crime and ASB.

The Vision's introduction includes a commitment to 'organisations working together, removing organisational boundaries and co-delivering services for the benefit of our residents'. This wording was included to meet a requirement expressed by Ron Hogg that the Vision should drive more effective operational working in addition to the relatively close strategic work that already exists.

The Vision was approved by the Chief Constable at an Executive Board meeting on 12 September 2019.

Decision: To approve the County Durham Vision 2035, and to communicate that decision to the County Durham Partnership.


