Title: Process for the allocation of the PCVC Community Safety Fund 2017 through the County Durham Community Foundation (CDCF)

Executive Summary: The 2017/18 PCVC Community Safety Fund will be launched on the County Durham Community Foundation website from 6th March 2017 closing on 28th April 2017. CDCF will administer the fund for a third year (following the tender award in 2014/15 for three years). The Police, Crime & Victims' Commissioner (PCVC), in partnership with County Durham Community Foundation (CDCF), is making available £150,000 for a grants fund to support the community and voluntary sector of County Durham and Darlington.

- Contribution from PCVC to the fund is £100,000
- Contribution from CDCF to the fund is £50,000
- PCVC is paying CDCF £15,000 to administer the fund

The fund will support projects and initiatives across County Durham & Darlington that help keep communities safe and contribute towards inspiring public confidence.

The fund is not aimed at organisations that are already funded directly from core commissioned, statutory policing and community safety activities, but will support projects and initiatives that are additional and work at a local community level.

The number of evaluation criteria has been reduced in order to manage the volumes of potential applications. The three criteria are to:

- Encourage diversionary activities
- Tackle anti-social behaviour
- Tackle harm caused by alcohol, drugs, and violence.

Grants of between £2,000 and £7,500 are available.

Decision: To confirm agreement that CDCF undertake the administration of the PCVC Community Safety Fund using the revised assessment criteria.


