**REQUEST: Continuation of Get Safe On-line agreement**

**Title:**

**Executive Summary:** GSOL are a not for profit organisation who offer a subsidised cybercrime, fraud and scam prevention products as part of the Government's Cyber Protect strategy. They are part of a Multi-Agency partnership and use commercial sponsorship to subsidise their work. Key initiatives which they undertake include:

- **Community Awareness Training** – Two sessions per year to train up to 40 people, enabling them to cascade key online safety messages.
- **Get Safe Online Live** – Two day public event, aimed at raising awareness of the general public of cyber crime and fraud.
- **Get Safe Online Business event** – provision of expert advice and logistical support to run a business event aimed at reducing fraud and cyber crime.

Delivery in the North East is managed under contract to NERSOU, and takes place in all three force areas. In recent years, the cost has been £30,000, shared equally between the three PCCs at £10,000 each.

**Decision:** After discussions between PCC offices and NERSOU, it was decided to continue the contract for 2017/18, funded from a NERSOU underspend. The cost in 2017/18 will be £27,000.




