REQUEST: To continue to contribute towards the National Rural Crime Network (NRCN) (£2,000)

Title: National Rural Crime

Background

Police and Crime Commissioners representing rural communities across England and Wales felt that more needed to be done to highlight the needs of the communities they represent. In addition, when considering the evidence base of what works in policing, there are opportunities to consider in greater detail effective policing, crime prevention and community safety in rural areas. As a consequence, 28 Police and Crime Commissioners with significantly rural constituencies came together to establish the NRCN in 2015.

The PCVC has been requested to continue to support the NRCN with a contribution of £2,000 for 2017/18. The NRCN champions a better understanding of crime in rural areas, and new, effective ways to keep rural communities safer. This research will help to ensure that the right services are in place locally and contribute to the provision of evidence about hidden demand in rural areas.

Decision: To continue to support the overall subscription to the NRCN to develop an in depth understanding of the needs and concerns of rural communities.


