


Key Decision No	003 / 2016
Subject:	Develop a Pre-Sentence Court based Restorative Justice Provision
Executive Summary	The PCC has received a proposal from Restorative Solutions (attached) to extend the Pre-Sentence Crown Court RJ Pilot into the Magistrates Courts and wider criminal justice system (including the Custody estate). This is building on the work to date and adding capacity to the restorative justice resources being developed by the OPCC.
Recommendation	The PCC is recommended to make a matched funding contribution of £20,000 towards the overall funding requirement of £47,750, the balance of which will be provided by Restorative Solutions
