Title: CDYOS Parent Support Group / Intervention Programme

Executive Summary:

County Durham YOS, Parent Support Group / Intervention Programme (£5,000): CDYOS Parenting Support Group (PSG) currently deliver an accredited parenting programme to parents/carers who have been victims of their son/daughter's offending, providing the opportunity for peer support.

The PSG work with groups of up to ten parents, contributing to a range of positive outcomes.

Post event evaluations show that nearly 90% of participants have developed improved relationships, better anger management strategies and enhanced communication skills with their children following this nine-week programme.

From October 2016 – March 2017 PSG has requested funding of £5,000 for a pilot programme to refine the interventions and the model used. This is an accredited parenting programme to reduce reoffending, avoid family breakdown using Restorative Justice approaches within families and improving relationships.

We recommend the PCVC agrees to allocate this funding.

Decision: The PCVC has agreed to grant fund £5000 in order to deliver the above programme.


