Title: County Durham YOS, Clear Cut Communications (Speech, Language and Communication Needs) SLCN

Executive Summary:

County Durham Youth Offending Service (CDYOS), Clear Cut Communication: Training & Resource Development (£10,000): Money has been requested by CDYOS to provide a specialist post within Clear Cut Communication to increase capacity to undertake training (through liaison with the RJ Co-ordinator for Durham & Darlington) and resources development for working with any victim of a young offender.

Increased capacity will allow for training in the use of Clear Cut resources, to be undertaken across Safe in Tees Valley.

The aim is to increase availability and range of resources for professionals and volunteers working with any victim of a young offender and provide multi-agency training both in recognising SLC needs and in use of the resources provided. In addition, further capacity could be used to develop work with Looked After children in Children's Homes to use SLCN resources in the delivery of restorative approaches.

Work to take place from November 2016 – March 2017 for this specialist post within Clear Cut Communication liaising with the RJ Co-ordinator to identify and scope training needs.

Decision: The PCVC has agreed to grant fund £10,000 in order to deliver the above programme.
