Executive Summary	Grant to the Durham Agency Against Crime of £12,500 (budget provision has been made for this cost)
Recommendation	<p>A request has been received from the Executive Manager of the DAAC (attached) for a contribution of £12,500 to support the ongoing delivery of activities that help sustain a number of projects aimed at young people such as supporting and creating safety initiatives, challenging behaviours and education to improve community safety in conjunction with partners across County Durham and Darlington. Through its various projects, the agency engaged with over 25,000 children over the last year, and has a track record of successful delivery. It is closely aligned to and supports key objectives in the Police and Crime Plan. Sufficient funding is available within your discretionary budget.</p> <p>The DAAC will be invited to submit a report twice per year identifying how the organisation is performing financially and what outcomes have been delivered during the first half of the financial year and the full year.</p> <p>We therefore recommend that you agree to this request.</p>
