



## Durham Police and Crime Commissioner Decision Record

<b>Key Decision No</b>	20150901
<b>Subject:</b>	Extension of RJ Project
<b>Executive Summary</b>	Following the appointment of the two RJ Coordinators, our findings have led us to conclude that in order to develop the service offer from a secure foundation there would be a benefit to develop a consistent style of RJ provision across the Force area. The proposal is to extend the model developed in Darlington into three areas within County Durham to test the effectiveness of the approach in different environments. It will also be possible to test differing approaches across these sites in order to develop a model which delivers a 'best fit' for County Durham and Darlington.
<b>Recommendation</b>	The PCC funds an extension of the RJ Project into three County Durham locations at an expected cost of £30,370.
