



Durham Police and Crime Commissioner Decision Record

Key Decision No	20151030
Subject:	Darlington Integrated Support for Victims Pilot (Extension)
Executive Summary	The Durham PCC approved this pilot for a period of six months on 22 nd June 2015. The pilot is demonstrating real learning and contributing towards improvements in the victim needs assessment process. The continuation of this pilot to the end of March 2016 would coincide with the introduction of the new service on 1 st April 2016 and enable the learning to be shared with and implemented by the successful service provider.
Recommendation	The PCC funds Victim Support to continue the pilot to the 31 st March 2016 at a cost of £14,906 in conjunction with the improvement projects set out in the main grant agreement (with Victim Support).
