



## Durham Police and Crime Commissioner Decision Record

<b>Key Decision No</b>	20151123
<b>Subject:</b>	Through the Eyes of a Child
<b>Executive Summary</b>	This pilot (inspired by Operation Encompass) will help the police, when attending a domestic abuse incident, assess the risk and provide a response based on that risk. Through the Eyes of the Child requires all attending officers to switch on their body worn cameras, identify if any children reside at the address and ensure how life through their eyes is captured. For medium and high risk cases this information is shared with Children Services to ensure the appropriate intervention and support is provided to the children.
<b>Recommendation</b>	The PCC is recommended contribute £10,000 to initially pilot this scheme.
