Subject:	Consideration of complaint against former Chief Constable
Executive Summary	The individual made a complaint against the former Chief Constable on the grounds that the Chief Constable did not respond personally to letters submitted by him. No evidence was found that the Chief Constable was personally aware of these letters as they had been sent to the Head of Professional Standards for investigation in line with Force procedures. Decision made to take no further action on this matter.


