Welcome to Hardin County, “a great place to live, work and prosper.” Hardin County is a fantastic location for you to build, invest, work, live, learn and love!


Hardin County is located in northwest Ohio, about a 60-minute drive from Columbus and Toledo. Our location is referred to as the heartland region, given we are within 500 miles of 60% of the US population and centralized to major US cities with corporate headquarters, retail operations, and manufacturing facilities.

The population in Hardin County is approximately 32,000 with a regional population (within 45 minutes) of over 820,000, making it a strong centralized hub within northwest Ohio.

The county is made up of nine communities (Ada, Alger, Dunkirk, Forest, Kenton, McGuffey, Mount Victory, Patterson and Ridgeway) and fifteen townships with the City of Kenton serving as the county seat.
