

FREE RAPID ANTIGEN TESTS FOR THE MOST VULNERABLE

Wellington Shire Council will provide COVID-19 rapid antigen tests (RATs) to eligible people until 30 June 2023.

The state government program provides RATs to people living with a disability, people who are immunocompromised, or anyone who may face barriers accessing tests under normal circumstances.

To continue to help with early detection and treatment of COVID-19, free rapid antigen tests are available to support those most vulnerable in our Wellington community, including:



- People aged 70 years or older
- People with a disability, immunocompromised people (self-declared) or their carer including NDIS
- participants, Disability support pensioners and people with a disability who receive a Transport Accident Commission benefit
- Commonwealth Concession Card holders including people with a Victorian Seniors card, Pensioner Concession card, Commonwealth Senior Health Care card and Health Care card, Low Income Health card and Department of Veterans' Affairs Gold, White or Orange cards.

Eligible people are encouraged to collect free tests from collection sites located at Council Customer Service Centres in Sale and Yarram, or at any Wellington Shire library branch.

Wellington libraries are located in Heyfield, Maffra, Rosedale, Sale, Stratford and Yarram.

A limit on the amount of test kits available per person will be at the discretion of Council.

Briagolong Fire Brigade Christmas Eve Santa run

Leave the Fire Station at 5pm and travel to:

Marathon Road, Valencia Creek Road intersection - Freestone Creek Road to Quarry Reserve Quarry Reserve to Coopers Road - Coopers Road to Boundary North Road

Boundary North Road to Boundary Road - Proceed along Boundary Road to Cemetery Road

Cemetery Road to Briagolong/Stratford Road - Briagolong/Stratford Road to Lees Road

Lees Road to Maffra/Briagolong Road - Proceed along Maffra/Briagolong Road to township

Arrive back in the township area around 6pm

Avon Street to Blundy Street then left to Cahill Street then right to Church Street
Move down Church Street to Fitzgibbon Street then down Fitzgibbon Street to Forbes Street
Right from Fitzgibbon Street along Forbes Street then turn right into Victoria Street
Along Victoria Street to Church Street then left along Church Street

From Church Street left into Rosstrevor Avenue

Along Rosstrevor Avenue to Forbes Street then left along Forbes Street to Victoria Street
Right into Victoria Street then drive to McMillan Street - Right into McMillan Street to Railway Avenue
Right into Railway Avenue and around to Smith Street

Across Station Street and along Smith Street to Victoria Street

Left into Victoria Street down to McLean Street - Left into McLean Street and drive to Station Street

Right into Station Street to Landy Street - Right into Landy Street and drive along to Victoria Street.

Turn right along Victoria Street and continue up to McLean Street and drive back to Station Street

Turn right and continue down Station Street to Forbes Street

Turn right along Forbes Street back to the Briagolong Hotel where Santa will dismount and hand out lollies to the patrons and their children between 7pm and 7.30pm

Travel along Forbes Street to Cahill Street. Turn left at Cahill Street. Return to Fire Station

We would appreciate it if the parents and children assemble at the street corners if possible.

This will make sure that Santa does not miss seeing any children. Listen for Santa's bell.

- Weekends and Public Holidays 10.30am 6pm




During the summer swim season, outdoor pools will open on days when the forecast at 4pm the previous day is for a temperature of 25 degrees celsius or higher in Sale. If you're planning on visiting, please make sure you check the <u>Bureau of Meteorology's website</u> and follow the <u>Aqua Energy Facebook page</u> to stay up to date with opening hours and important information about outdoor pools and the summer swim season.

During peak season, outdoor pools will be open 12 - 3pm regardless of the temperature, and lap swimming will be available at Maffra, Sale and Yarram outdoor pools between 6am - 8am weekdays throughout the entire summer swim season.


